

Hogwatch Camera Trap Loan agreement



A camera trap used by the *Going Wild in Bishop's Castle* project will be loaned to the home owner under the following conditions:

- 1. This camera trap loan agreement is signed by the participant and returned to a staff member of the *Going Wild in Bishop's Castle* project before the camera is borrowed. It will be kept on file in a secure G-drive folder in accordance with our privacy policy.
- 2. Use of this equipment for any purpose other than recording images or videos of wildlife (ie, non-human subjects) may result in the participant being removed from the project.
- 3. This device may only be used on private land, with the express permission of the land owner.
- 4. The digital storage cards (SD) associated with these devices may not be altered, nor used for activities other than recording wildlife.
- 5. Participants accept full financial responsibility for any loss/theft of the equipment while it is in the participant's possession. The cost of the repair or replacement of this equipment caused by neglect, careless handling or improper care is also the participants responsibility. The replacement cost for this camera trap is £100.00. The replacement cost of the SD card only is £10.00. The replacement cost of the batteries is £20.00.
- **6.** Participants must return the camera trap that has been loaned for their use after the 2 week loan period. Failure to return the camera trap will result in loss of camera trap privileges. The camera traps, which are the property of various private individuals or the Shropshire Wildlife Trust, must be returned within at least 1 week from the end of the loan period *in the condition it was provided*.
